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UAE salaries set to rise in 2024

DUBAI: Job market projections in the UAE are looking good for workers in the country, as two salary guides released recently expect salaries to rise and also highlight the roles that are going to be in demand in different sectors.

According to a salary guide released by Cooper Fitch, salaries in the UAE are expected to grow by 4.5pc with 56pc of companies that responded to their survey saying that they expect to hire more people in 2024. As much as 53 pc of this year's respondents also said that they plan to raise wages, according to the recruit-

ment agency's report.

The Cooper Fitch survey also noted that hiring from outside the UAE may increase, as 27pc of

respondents said that they may look for talent from outside the UAE.

Another salary guide released by Robert Half, an international recruitment agency, found that 69pc UAE-based workers who were surveyed planned to move to a new company in 2024. Nevertheless, the market outlook, as per the Robert Half Salary Guide 2024 has some words of caution for job seekers. While companies are still making new hires, the report found that a majority of the roles were replacements, rather than newly created roles. "So while there is churn, there are a limited number of opportunities for candidates," said Robert Half. **(Cont. on page-2)**

SalamAir to start services to Mumbai, Bangalore

MUSCAT: Budget airline SalamAir will add Mumbai and Bangalore to its list of new destinations from September, bringing its number of destinations in India to eight.

The expansion of SalamAir's operational operations in the Republic of India comes within the framework of enhancing strategic plans and meeting the growing demand for travel between Oman, India and the GCC. On Sept 2, SalamAir will start operating its first flights to Mumbai, with four weekly flights, while its flights to Bangalore will start operating on Sept 6, 2024, with two weekly flights.

Adrian Hamilton Mans, CEO of SalamAir, said that

the company sought to increase its network of destinations in the vital Indian subcontinent region to provide diverse travel options at competitive prices, noting that with the launch of the Mumbai and Bangalore stations, SalamAir reaches eight destinations in India, in addition to Delhi, Kozhikode, Chennai, Lucknow, Jaipur and Hyderabad.

SalamAir commenced operations in 2017 with a focus on developing affordable air travel to Oman. SalamAir serves six domestic destinations in Oman and 37 cities in 18 countries

Sheikh Hasina quits, flees to India



NEW DELHI: Bangladesh PM Sheikh Hasina resigned and fled to India today following a civil war-like condition in her country. According to latest reports, she has landed in Hindon IAF base at Ghaziabad (near Delhi). It is almost

certain that India will give political asylum to Hasina. In a televised address to the nation, Army chief Wakeruz-Zaman said the military would form the interim government. The streets of Bangladesh saw fierce clashes on Sunday, with the death toll mounting to at least 300.

'Help for Wayanad' cell formed

NEW DELHI: Flood-ravaged state of Kerala has set up a special cell called "Help for Wayanad" within the state government to co-ordinate relief and rehabilitation efforts in the areas affected by the huge disaster.

So far, 219 people are confirmed dead in massive landslides caused by torrential rains in Wayanad district during monsoon. Of these, 98 are men, 90 are women and 31 are children, it was officially confirmed. More than 200 people are still missing.



The "Help for Wayanad" cell will bring together worldwide offers from Indians abroad to donate land for rehabilitation of displaced people, promises to build relief housing and financial contributions to the State Chief Minister's Disaster Relief Fund. Kerala's Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan has given special powers to officials of the state's finance department to provide speedy relief to survivors of those killed by landslides and house collapses.

The new cell has created an email account with the address letushelpwayanad@gmail.com inviting suggestions, especially from overseas Indians for relief and rehabilitation in Wayanad.

Worried expats try to bring in their families to UAE

DUBAI: In the wake of the recent calamities that have caused widespread destruction in India and Pakistan, UAE residents are making arrangements to bring their families to UAE. Worried expats want their loved ones to be by their side till heavy rains and floods back

home subside.

Avinash Hegde, a corporate lawyer based in Dubai and originally from Mangalore, has decided to bring his family to the UAE after authorities evacuated many families from his hometown due to flooding. "Our house is close to the Kulur Riv-

er, which is flooding due to heavy rainfall. Most of the families living in and around the river have been evacuated by the authorities to safety. However, I decided to bring my parents and my sister to Dubai until the situation is normal," said Hegde.

Saba Ansari, another

Dubai resident, has also taken measures to safeguard her family from the severe weather in Mumbai. The city is bracing for increased rainfall activity in the coming days, with the India Meteorological Department (IMD) issuing a yellow alert. "Recently, a building col-

lapsed near our home in Navi Mumbai, and many residents are in fear and have relocated to different places," said Ansari. "I have asked my brother to come to Dubai for a few days until the heavy rain subsides. Normally, the rain subsides in the middle of August every year," said Ansari.

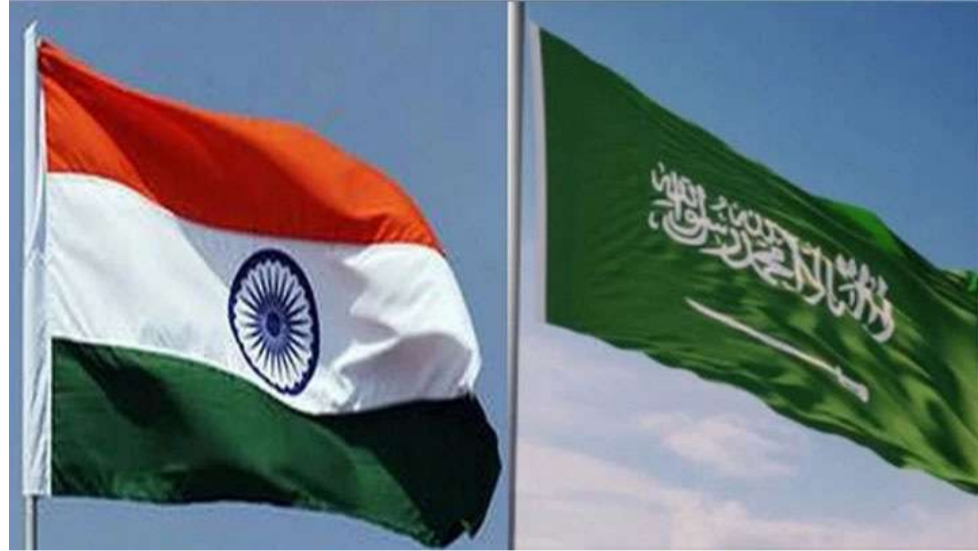
Investment task force meeting heralds new era in India-Saudi trade ties

RIYADH: Trade and economic relations between India and Saudi Arabia have taken another step forward after the countries' inaugural High-Level Task Force on Investments was held earlier this week.

The body was set up in 2023 when the Kingdom's Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman made an official visit to the Asian nation – a visit that came four years after he pledged investments worth \$100 billion in India during a trip to New Delhi.

The first meeting of the task force was held virtually on July 28, and was co-chaired by Saudi Arabia's Energy Minister Prince Abdulaziz bin Salman and PK Mishra, principal secretary to Prime Minister Narendra Modi. During the talk, India invited Saudi Arabia's Pub-

lic Investment Fund to establish an office in the Asian nation, as it seeks to attract funds from the



Kingdom.

“Constructive discussions were held on various opportunities for bilateral investments in diverse areas in public and private sector, including refining and petrochemical plants, new and renewable energy, power, telecom, innovation, among others,” said prime minister's office in New Delhi in a statement after the High-Level Task

Force meeting.

When the crown prince visited India in 2023, on the sidelines of the G20

Leaders' Summit and to co-chair the first Leaders' Meeting of the India-Saudi Arabia Strategic Partnership Council, both countries signed eight agreements across several fields including energy, banking, and investment, as well as manufacturing, archival cooperation, anti-corruption and water desalination.

Data from the Indian

embassy in Riyadh revealed that more than 2.65 million Indians are living in Saudi Arabia, who act as a “living bridge between the two countries.”

The statement further stated that an empowered delegation led by the country's petroleum secretary will visit Saudi Arabia for follow-up discussions on the mutually beneficial investment in the oil and gas sector. Both countries also agreed to regular consultations between their technical teams to take forward the discussions and reach an agreement on specific investments. India also invited the Saudi energy minister to visit New Delhi for the next round of High-Level Task Force meetings.

Even though India and Saudi Arabia have been sharing strong economic and trade relations since

1947, their bilateral ties took a new turn after the signing of the Delhi Declaration in 2006. It was followed by the Riyadh Declaration in 2010 when then prime minister Manmohan Singh visited Saudi, elevating the bilateral relationship to a strategic partnership between both nations.

Later, the visit of Modi to Saudi Arabia in 2016 captured the spirit of enhanced co-operation in the political, economic, security and defense realms between Riyadh and New Delhi.

Apart from the growing economic and trade ties, India and Saudi Arabia also share a strong emotional and cultural relationship, with the Kingdom being the most sought-after destination for Indian talents and religious tourists.

Banks on hiring spree

MUMBAI: The banking sector is on a hiring spree poised to experience the most substantial net employment growth at an impressive 7.21pc positioning it as the leader in employment expansion within the banking, financial services and insurance (BFSI) sector, said a report.

“The Employment Outlook Report” for the first-half of fiscal 2025 (April 2024 to Sept 2025) by TeamLease Services said that closely following the banking sector is the NBFC sector (Non-Banking Financial Companies) that is expected to witness significant employment growth with a projected net increase of 5.41pc, signifying their ambitious workforce expansion plans. On the same lines, the insurance sector is projected to demonstrate steady growth, with a net employment increase of 5.25pc, reflecting the industry's focus on meeting requirements in regulatory compliance, cyber security and heightened customer engagement said the report.

Meanwhile, FinTech exhibits the lowest growth among the mentioned sectors, with forecast net employment growth of 4.89pc albeit still indicating a favourable hiring trend. This growth is attributed to the rise of UPI and the expansion of the open banking ecosystem.” Regarding employers' intent to calibrate workforce sizes, NBFCs demonstrate the highest propensity to expand their workforce. The findings of a survey-based report reveal that 65pc of respondents plan to increase their workforce, while 16pc intend to reduce it and 19pc anticipate no change. Within the banking sector, 60pc of respondents express plans to enlarge their workforce, while 20pc intend to downsize it, and an additional 20pc foresee no changes.

“The resilient Indian banking industry is poised for significant development in growth areas such as retail lending, SME financing, and digital banking, driven by increased credit demand.

UAE visa amnesty: how overstay grace period helped expats

DUBAI: The UAE announced a two-month amnesty programme that will start on September 1 this year to “allow violators with a new opportunity to regularise their visa status”. After years of living illegally, many expats could see their families, friends and loved ones again, thanks to the country's amnesty scheme.

Six years ago, on August 1, 2018, the UAE had launched its third

residency amnesty since 2007. This gave hopes to thousands to no longer live in fear as they started afresh. The move allowed many residency violators to adjust their status or leave the country easily.

Although it was announced only for 90 days until Oct 31, 2018, the federal government extended it until Dec 31. Those who resolved their absconding cases could regularise their employment and

residency status. One individual even returned home to marry after her huge overstaying fine was waived.

After Thursday's announcement, Federal Authority for Identity, Citizenship, Customs and Port Security (ICP) will soon reveal the procedures for the latest amnesty. In the meantime, we look back at how the last amnesty programme had kicked off, officials said.

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Bangladesh unrest: India issues travel advisory for citizens

NEW DELHI: India has “strongly advised” its nationals against travelling to Bangladesh in the wake of the surge in violence in the neighbouring country.

New Delhi’s diplomatic and consular mission in Dhaka stated that Indian Visa Application Centres in Bangladesh would remain closed on Monday. India also asked its nationals in Bangladesh to exercise “extreme caution”.

India is cautiously and closely monitoring the situation in Bangladesh, where the

demand for the resignation of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina’s government grew louder after fierce clashes between protesters and security personnel led to the death of nearly 100 people across the country over reservations

“In view of ongoing developments, Indian nationals are strongly advised against travelling to Bangladesh till further notice,” the MEA stated in a travel advisory.

“All Indian nationals presently in Bangladesh are advised to exercise extreme cau-

tion, restrict their movements and remain in contact with the High Commission of India in Dhaka through their emergency phone numbers.”

India’s assistant high commission in Sylhet in eastern Bangladesh also issued an advisory in the wake of the escalation of clashes between protesters and the security personnel. It asked Indians, including students, living in Sylhet and adjoining areas in Bangladesh to remain alert and keep in touch with its officials through helpline numbers.

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GULF FAQs

How to recover money loaned to a friend?

I loaned a friend Dh50,000 about three months ago. He was to repay it in a month, but he hasn't. I had bank-transferred the amount to him, so I have proof I gave him the money. What can I do here?

It is assumed that the loan does not bear any interest. Therefore, the provision of the

or opt to cancel (rescind) the contract altogether. This is discussed in Article (272) (1) of the UAE Civil Transactions Law: "In bilateral contracts, if one of the parties does not perform his contractual obligations, the other party may, after serving a formal notification to the debtor, demand the per-



UAE civil transactions law and the UAE civil procedures law are applicable.

In UAE, a contract must be executed according to its terms and in alignment with the principles of good faith where it requires parties to fulfil their contractual obligations honestly and fairly. This is in accordance with Article (246) (1) of the Federal Law No. (5) of 1985 On the Civil Transactions Law of the United Arab Emirates which reads as, "The contract must be performed in accordance with its contents, and in a manner consistent with the requirements of good faith."

Furthermore, the principle of contract is the mutual agreement (assent) of the parties involved and the acceptance to fulfil their obligation as stated in the contract. This is provided under Article (257) of the UAE Civil Transactions Law: "The principle in contracts is the assent of the parties and the contractual obligations they are bound to perform".

In addition, if any party fails to fulfil his or her contractual obligations, the aggrieved party has the right to issue a formal notice to the defaulting party. Following this notification, a non-defaulting party can choose to demand that the contract be fulfilled as agreed

performance of the contract or its rescission."

Additionally, in the event of a breach of contract, a claimant may approach the First Instance Court in the relevant emirate in the UAE to claim from the other party his or her civil rights. This is in accordance with Article 24 of the Federal Decree Law No. 42 of 2022 Promulgating the Civil Procedure Code, which states: "The Courts of First Instance have the jurisdictions to hear all claims, dispute and proceedings of first instance, except for those excluded under a special provision."

In addition, a claimant may file a civil case against a defendant in the emirate where the defendant resides. This is in accordance with Article 33 of the UAE Civil Procedures Code, which states: "The court, within the territorial jurisdiction of which the defendant's domicile is located, shall have the jurisdiction over the case, unless the law provides otherwise. If the defendant has no domicile in the state, the court, within the territorial jurisdiction of which the defendant's place of residence or workplace is located, shall have the jurisdiction."

You should retain all documents and evidence including relevant electronic communications such as any texts,

SMS or email (if any) as you may need it to pursue legal action to recover the outstanding amount from your friend. You may send a formal legal notice to your friend, clearly stating the terms of the loan agreement, the amount owed and request your friend to

repay the Dh50,000 in accordance within the agreed timeline. You may consider seeking advice from a legal practitioner in the UAE to understand your options for enforcing the loan agreement if your friend fails to respond to your notice.

Can one sublet his Dubai flat?

I have a two-bedroom flat in Dubai that I rented to an individual to stay with his family. I recently learned about another person staying at the flat. I suspect the family has sublet a room in the flat without my knowledge. What are my legal rights here? What should I do?

A tenant is not allowed to sub-let rented premises allotted to them without a landlord's written consent unless they agree on it in a rent agreement in Dubai. This is by Article 24 of Law No. 26 of 2007 Regulating the Relationship between Landlords and Tenants in Dubai, which states: "Unless otherwise agreed by the parties to a lease contract, the tenant may not sublease or assign the use of the real property to third parties unless the relevant written consent of the landlord is obtained."

Furthermore, a landlord may evict a tenant by serving a notice through a notary public or by registered post if they sublet rented premises to a third party without a landlord's written consent. This is in accordance with Article 25 (1) (b) of Law No. 33 of 2008 Amending Law No. 26 of 2007 Regulating the Relationship Between Landlords and Tenants Dubai, which states: "A landlord may request eviction of the tenant from the Real Property before the expiry of the lease contract only in following cases:

Where the tenant sublets the real property or any part thereof without obtaining the landlord's written approval, in which case the eviction shall apply to the tenant and to the subtenant, who shall reserve the right to claim compensation from the tenant.

Under these provisions of law, the tenant may have violated the terms of the rent agreement with you by subletting a room of your apartment without your written consent.

Moreover, as the amended Dubai Tenancy Law outlines, such actions may result in eviction proceedings against both the tenant and the subtenant by serving an eviction notice through a notary public or registered post.

Therefore, as the apartment's owner, you are legally entitled to initiate relevant action against your tenant for breaching the terms of the rent agreement signed between you and your tenant. You may consider the following steps: Review rent agreement: Check your tenancy agreement for any specific clauses regarding subletting and consent requirements.

Communicate with a tenant: Initially, discuss the issue with your tenant both verbally and in writing (either by email or letter), stating that he has sublet the portion of the rented apartment to a third party without obtaining your written consent and request him to either make arrangements to vacate the subtenant and compensate you monetarily for the damages caused to you (if any). Send a formal notice: You may consider issuing a formal written notice to your tenant through a Notary Public or by registered post, stating that they breach the rental agreement by subletting without your consent and requesting immediate eviction of the rented apartment.

Consider legal action: If the tenant and the subtenant do not evict based on the eviction notice (as mentioned above), you may consider approaching the Dubai Rental Dispute Centre (RDC) to initiate legal proceedings. RDC have jurisdiction over all disputes between the owner and tenant of any real estate property in Dubai. If no crime has been committed, Dubai police generally may not have jurisdiction.

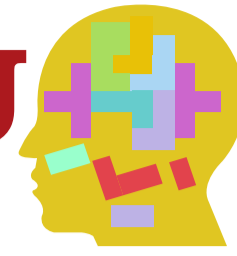
