A I Express Amritsar-Abu Dhabi direct flight from Oct 29

ABU DHABI: Air India Express will start a direct flight between Amritsar and Abu Dhabi from Oct 29, offering a new connectivity option for passengers travelling between Punjab and the UAE.

The flight will operate three times a week on Thursdays, Saturdays and Sundays, according to booking details available on the airline's website and travel portals.

The flight will depart

from Amritsar at 8.40 pm and arrive in Abu Dhabi at 11.50 pm the same day. The return flight will leave Abu Dhabi at 12.55 am on Fridays, Sundays and Mondays and reach Amritsar at 6.15 am. The scheduled flying time is about four hours and 40 minutes from Amritsar and three hours and 50 minutes on the return sector.

Sameep Singh Gumtala, global convener of the Fly-Amritsar Initiative, said the

China Southern Airlines to resume Delhi-Guangzhou flights from Sept 21

NEW DELHI: China Southern Airlines will resume daily direct flights between New Delhi and Guangzhou from Sept 21, 2026, ending a six-year suspension. The service, operated using Boeing 737

aircraft, marks the airline's return to India and comes amid improving bilateral ties, expanding air connectivity and efforts to boost trade, tourism, student travel and people-to-people exchanges.

The announcement also coincides with Chinese President Xi Jinping's visit to India for the BRICS Summit, adding significance to the restoration of the air link between the two countries. The restart comes amid a gradual revival of direct air connectivity be-

GCC visa to boost tourism

The GCC is all set to launch its unified tourist visa soon, bringing a single regional travel permit closer to implementation across six Gulf states, similar to Schengen . Visitors using the permit will gain easier travel between the UAE, Saudi Arabia, Qatar, Bahrain, Kuwait and Oman. Indians will be one of the greatest beneficiaries of this common visa.

No doubt, easier regional travel will support tourism and strengthen the GCC's position as an integrated destination. Tour operators will gain greater flexibility when packaging itineraries across several GCC destinations. Airlines can also combine regional networks with trips covering multiple cities under one visitor authorisation.

Generally, the proposed GCC common visa is compared with Schengen visa. What's a Schengen visa? It's an entry permit that lets non-EU nationals make short, temporary visits of up to 90 days within any 180-day period to member-countries in the Schengen area. With a valid Schengen visa, one can travel freely across all 29 member-countries of the Schengen area for short stays up to 90 days within any 180-day.

Jasem Mohamed Albudaiwi, GCC Secretary General, confirmed the latest timetable during the Security and History Dialogue in Riyadh. He said the project was approaching implementation following technical and regulatory co-ordination between member-states.

Foreign visitors will gain easier access across participating countries once authorities activate the unified system. Albudaiwi remarked: "This will represent an important step towards strengthening Gulf integration and facilitate the movement of visitors among the GCC countries."

GCC passport authorities have spent more than a year co-ordinating the technical requirements needed for a shared tourist visa system. The passport departments within GCC Interior Ministries were holding continuous joint technical meetings on the project. Teams were reviewing technology requirements, security procedures and implementation mechanisms before launch.

GCC authorities designed the permit to reduce separate visa procedures for international travellers planning multi-destination Gulf itineraries. Public details covering fees, visa validity and eligible nationalities were not included in Albudaiwi's Sept 6 remarks. Unified access will connect six major Gulf tourism markets through a common tourist visa once implementation begins.

Saudi Tourism Minister His Excellency Ahmed Al Khateeb had previously identified 2026 as the launch year during a tourism investment forum in Bahrain in Nov 2025. September's announcement narrows that timetable further, with Albudaiwi describing implementation as close. The UAE and Bahrain have already advanced separate work designed to streamline passenger processing between GCC airports. GCC authorities launched the first phase of a "One Stop Travel" project between both countries on Feb 17, 2026. That programme remains separate from the unified tourist visa. Its deployment shows ongoing investment in connected passenger processing and cross-border travel systems within the GCC.

UAE aviation infrastructure gives the regional programme access to one of the Gulf's largest international passenger gateways. Dubai, Abu Dhabi, Riyadh, Jeddah, Doha, Manama, Kuwait City and Muscat can sit within a single visitor journey once the permit becomes operational.

GCC authorities are also expanding tourism co-ordination with international markets. Officials had met European Union representatives on Sept 1 to discuss destination promotion, tourism platforms and preparations for a Gulf European tourism forum. Implementation has reached its final regulatory and technical stages, placing the unified tourist visa among the GCC's most advanced regional travel projects in 2026.

Omanis told to take health insurance cover while travelling to India

MUMBAI: The Consulate General of the Sultanate of Oman in Mumbai has urged Omani citizens arriving in India and Omani students studying here to obtain a comprehensive and valid health insurance that covers the costs of treatment and medical care throughout their stay.

This recommendation comes in light of the increasing number of cases requiring medical care and hospital treatment and the potentially high financial costs, especially in cases requiring in-

tensive care, the Consulate General said.

Accordingly, the Consulate General emphasized the necessity for health insurance to cover treatment in accidents and emergencies, the provision of medications, and medical evacuation when needed. The Consulate General recommended that Omani students, in particular, ensure they obtain suitable health insurance that covers their stay in India, to ensure their safety and avoid any unexpected financial burdens.

new service would particularly benefit workers, families and business travellers who frequently travel between Punjab and Abu Dhabi.

"Many passengers travelling to Abu Dhabi have to either fly from Delhi or travel from Amritsar to Dubai or Sharjah and continue their journey by road. Direct connectivity will save time and reduce travel costs and inconvenience," he said.

Yogesh Kamra, convenor of the initiative, said the new service would fur-

ther strengthen Amritsar's position as Punjab's international gateway. With the addition of Abu Dhabi, connectivity between Amritsar and the UAE is expected to reach 31 weekly flights each way to Dubai, Sharjah and Abu Dhabi, subject to changes in airline schedules, he said.

He also urged Air India Express and other Indian carriers to introduce direct flights from Amritsar to more destinations in the Gulf, including Muscat and Kuwait, where a large number of Punjabis live and work.

tween India and China, with bilateral ties showing signs of improvement and airlines from both countries restoring services between major cities. China Southern will operate one daily round trip between Indira Gandhi International Airport and Guangzhou Baiyun International Airport. Flight CZ359 from Guangzhou is scheduled to depart at around 3:35 pm and arrive in New Del-

hi at approximately 7 pm. The return flight, CZ360, is expected to leave Delhi at around 8pm to 8:20pm and reach Guangzhou at about 4:15 am the following day. The service will be operated using Boeing 737 aircraft, including the 737-8/MAX 8 series.

The resumption makes China Southern the third major Chinese carrier to restore flights to India, following China Eastern Airlines and Air China. China Eastern has already resumed services connecting Shanghai and Delhi, besides operating the Kunming-Kolkata route. Air China restarted its Beijing-Delhi service in April 2026. Indian airlines has also been gradually restoring and expanding connectivity with Chinese destinations.

Direct air links between India and China were largely suspended around 2020 amid the COVID-19 pandemic and subsequently remained disrupted during a period of strained bilateral relations following tensions along the border.

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Tata Sons to go public, Chandrasekaan to remain chairman

MUMBAI: Tata Sons 11, 2026, and directed it to proceed with an immediate listing. The board has cleared listing of the company and five-year term for N Chandrasekaran as Tata Sons chairman. Tata Trusts, which own about 66pc of Tata Sons, had opposed an initial public offering (IPO), while the Shapoorji Pallonji Group, with around 18.4 pc has pushed for a listing to unlock value and improve liquidity. In Sept 2022, RBI had classified Tata Sons as an upper-layer non-banking financial company, requiring it to list within three years. Tata Sons subsequently repaid its debt and sought to surrender its core investment company registration to remain privately held, but RBI rejected the application on Sept

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GULF FAQs

UAE's five-year multiple-entry tourist visa: total cost, how it works, documents need?

Can you please explain the details of the new single UAE multiple entry visa ?

Frequent visitors to Dubai can apply for a five-year multiple-entry tourist visa that allows them to enter the country multiple times without a local sponsor or host. The self-sponsored visa is available to travellers of all nationalities who meet the eligibility requirements, allowing them to stay in the UAE for up to 90 days on each visit, with the option to extend for another 90 days.

Here is everything you need to know about the visa, including the eligibility requirements, documents, cost and how to apply. What is the five-year multiple-entry tourist visa? Issued through the General Directorate of Identity and Foreigners Affairs – Dubai (GDRFA Dubai), the self-sponsored visa is open to visitors of all nationalities, subject to meeting the eligibility requirements.

The visa is valid for five years and allows holders to



enter and leave the UAE multiple times during that period. Visitors can stay in the UAE for up to 90 days on each visit, with the option to extend their stay for a further 90 days. However, the total time spent in the UAE must not exceed 180 days in a calendar year. The visa is designed for tourists, frequent travellers, family visitors and business travellers who regularly visit the UAE and require greater flexibility than a standard tourist visa.

What documents do you

need? Applicants must provide the following documents when applying:

* A valid passport with at least six months' validity .

*Proof of valid health insurance.

*A round-trip ticket.

*Bank statements covering the previous six months.

The bank statement must be in the applicant's name and attested. Applicants must also show that they have maintained a bank balance of at least \$4,000 (Dh14,690), or the equivalent in another currency,

during the six months preceding the application. Applicants must also have valid health insurance for their stay in the UAE. There are UAE-based insurance providers that offer emergency health insurance for visitors and tourists.

Note: The documents listed above are the mandatory basic documents required for all applicants. Depending on the information provided in the application, GDRFA Dubai may request additional documents or information. How much does the five-

year tourist visa cost? The total application cost is around Dh3,713, according to GDRFA Dubai. This includes visa fees, service charges and a refundable financial guarantee. Applicants applying from inside the UAE may also have to pay additional fees for changing their visa status.

Estimated cost breakdown: *Application Fee: Dh100* Issuance Fee: Dh500 *Guarantee amount: Dh3000* Warranty service fee: Dh21

*Fee for collection and return of the guarantee: Dh20 *Knowledge Dirham: Dh10

Innovation Dirham: Dh10 Service Fee: Dh52.5 * Total: Dh3,713.

However, the final amount may vary depending on the applicant's individual circumstances and any additional requirements.

How do you keep track of your permitted stay? Visa holders are responsible for ensuring that they do not exceed the permitted number of days in the UAE. Travellers can request a travel report (entry/exit report) to check their entry and exit records and determine how many days they have spent in the country.

The report can also help visitors or their representatives ensure that their stay remains within the permitted duration and avoid overstaying penalties. The visa is valid for entry within two months of the date it is issued.

This period can be extended for an additional two months. The one-year period for calculating the permitted stay begins from the date of the traveller's first entry into the UAE.

Can your employer refuse to pay overtime?

I work at a hotel, nine hours daily according to my contract. My employer requested me to work 10 hours a day during the summer time and assured that I would be compensated for the additional overtime hours. I agreed, but he refused to pay arguing that there was no written agreement between us concerning the additional working hours. Is the employer entitled to do this? What legal action

should I take in these circumstances?

According to Article 19 of the Federal Decree Law No. 33 of 2021, the employer may instruct the worker to work overtime over the normal working hours, provided that they do not exceed two hours per day. The worker may not be instructed to work for more than that period, except in accordance with the conditions and rules specified by the Implementing. In all cases, the total working hours shall not exceed 144

hours every three weeks.

Having no written agreement regarding working extra working hours means that the burden of proof lies on you, to prove that the additional working hours were performed at the employer's request, with the employer's knowledge and approval. Such evidences may include WhatsApp messages, SMS messages, emails or other written communications from the employer, work schedules, attendance records, time

sheets, instructions, assignments or work-related communications issued during the additional working hours; and any other documentary or electronic evidence establishing that the additional working hours were performed at the employer's request and with the employer's knowledge.

So, you have to file a complaint in front of the Labor office and the court will assess the submitted evidences and render the judgment.
