India-UK sign Free Trade Agreement

LONDON: Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Thursday formally signed the long-awaited Free Trade Agreement (FTA) between India and the United Kingdom as he met British Prime Minister Keir Starmer, marking what both countries have described as a turning point in bilateral relations.

The FTA is expected to benefit 99pc Indian exports from tariff and will firms to export whisky, cars and other products to India besides boosting the overall trade basket.

Tourism potential

Tourism has long been described as an "industry without pollution". No wonder, many countries have given industry status to tourism. India has always envied top leading tourist countries such as France, Spain, and the US. These countries consistently rank high in international tourist arrivals, attracting millions of visitors annually. Other prominent destinations include China, Italy, Turkey, Mexico, Thailand, Germany and the UK.

The World Travel and Tourism Council has calculated that tourism generated Rs 13.2-lakh-crore (\$160 billion) or 5.8pc of India's GDP and supported 32.1 million jobs in 2021. Even though these numbers were lower than the pre-pandemic figures, the country's economy witnessed a significant growth in 2021 after the massive downturn during 2020. This sector is predicted to grow at an annual rate of 7.8pc to Rs 33.8-lakh-crore (\$400

Little Vaidyanathan lished itself as the fifth largest global travel healthcare decimal estimated market size of around \$9 billion in 2019, out of the total global travel healthcare industry of \$44.8 billion(2019).On the medical tourism, 184,298 foreign patients travelled to India to seek treatment in 2024.

Till a few years back, tourism was not a priority sector for the government of India. In this connection, the statement by Union Tourism Minister Gajendra Singh Shekhawat that India is aiming to align the share of tourism in the country's GDP to global benchmarks is most welcome... In other words, the government is targeting to increase the share of tourism to 10pc of the GDP by 2030. "Our vision is to enhance the tourism sector's contribution to GDP to 10pc by 2030. India is progressing economically and the perception of tourism has changed significantly since Covid-19. We are working with the states towards experiential tourism," Shekhawat said in his address at the CII Annual Business Summit in New Delhi.

Incidentally, India is resuming issuing tourist visas to the Chinese from July 24, 2025. This move comes as India and China work to repair their ties which took a turn for the south after the 2020 Galwan Valley clash. Citing the Indian embassy in Beijing, news agency Reuters reported that this renewal is set to start from Thursday, July 24, 2025. "From July 24, 2025, Chinese citizens can apply for a tourist visa to visit India. They must first fill out the visa application form online on the web link and print it, and then make an appointment on the web link. Then they must take a passport, visa application form and other related documents to submit an application at the Indian Visa Application Centre," read the post issued by the Indian embassy.

India has festivals round the year. These include Diwali, Holi, Eid and numerous regional and tribal festivals, offering a glimpse into the country's rich cultural diversity.





Who pays penalties if car ownership is not transferred?

I sold my car to a friend for Dh10,000, but we did not complete the ownership transfer. Subsequently, I began receiving messages about traffic fines incurred on the vehicle. I asked my friend to pay the fines, but he refused. Due to the car's poor condition, I ended up selling it for just Dh1,500 to cover some of the fines. However, I have recently discovered that there are still outstanding fines totalling Dh12,000 registered against the car. My friend continues to refuse any responsibility for these penalties. From a legal standpoint, what options are available to me in this situation?
